According to Downes (2005)

Web 2.0 refers to a group of technologies such as blogs, wikis, Pod casts, RSS, Feeds etc where everyone is able to add and edit the content creating a socially networked web environment (**Anderson 2007**).

O' Reilly (2005) define web 2.0 as a platform spanning all connected devices. It is the new functions that allow for great interactivity and connection between users.
