STUDY OF RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN PERSONALITY TRAITS AND PROFESSIONAL INTEREST: A CASE STUDY OF SECONDARY SCHOOL **STUDENTS**

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Abstract: Personality traits and Professional interests are influenced numerous outcomes associated with work and life success. One common thread that links Personality traits and Professional interests is that they influence behavior through motivational processes. The study tries to find out the compatibilities among profession choice decisions and the personality type of the incumbents opting for job because people make decisions of their career choices and their personality types. The results showed that there were significant relationships between the creativity, emotional stability, social and enterprising types on one hand and professional interest on the other.

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In the above table, the coefficient of correlation between Personality traits and Professional interest is found to be .46. The obtained tr value 10.335 is greater than the table value 1.96 at 0.05 level of significant with the degrees of freedom 398. Hence the null hypothesis was rejected as untenable and the findings are said to be statistically significant. This means that there is significant relationship between Personality traits and Professional interest among higher secondary school students.

The present investigation resulted in a number of findings as presented below.

- The coefficient of correlation between personality traits and Professional interest is found to be .46. The obtained tr value 10.335 is greater than the table value 1.96 at 0.05 level of significant. There is significant relationship between personality traits and professional interest among higher secondary school students.
- The coefficient of correlation between creativity and Professional interest is found to be 0.43. The obtained tr value 5.063 is greater than the table value 1.96 at 0.05 level of significance. There is significant relationship between creativity and professional interest of higher secondary school students.
- The coefficient of correlation between Emotional stability to experience and Professional interest is found to be .44 The obtained tr value 4.299 is greater than the table value 1.96 at 0.05 level of significant. There is significant relationship between openness to experience and Professional interest of higher secondary school students.
- The coefficient of correlation between social and Professional interest is found to be .46. The obtained tr value 3.63 is greater than the table value 1.96 at 0.05 level of significant. There is significant relationship between emotional stability and Professional interest among higher secondary school students.
- The coefficient of correlation between enterprising types and Professional interest is found to be .39. The obtained tr value 2.872 is greater than the table value 1.96 at 0.05 level of significance with degrees of freedom 46. There is significant relationship between agreeableness and Professional interest among higher secondary school students.

Conclusion of the Study

In this study the investigator made an attempt to analyse the relationship between personality traits and Professional interest of higher secondary school students. For this purpose Investigator uses personality traits Inventory and Professional interest record. The study revealed that there was a significant positive relationship exists between personality traits and Professional interest of higher secondary school students. On the basis of the findings of the study of the following recommendations are made for implementing in the field of education ie., Personality factors influence the Professional interest, so it is essential to develop good Personality traits among students. The influence of the personality factors on Professional interest is revealed in the study. Proper care should be given for the development of Personality traits which positively influence Professional interest. Personality traits inventories should be administrated in educational institutions in order to identify the distribution of those traits among students.
