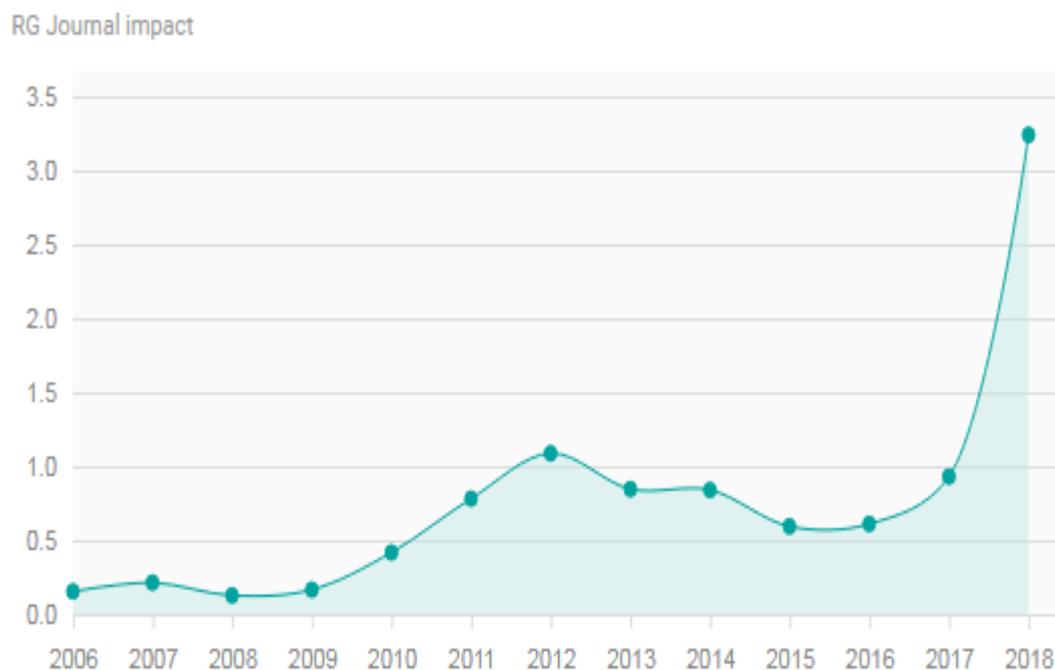


Fig 2. Journal Impact Factor Trend

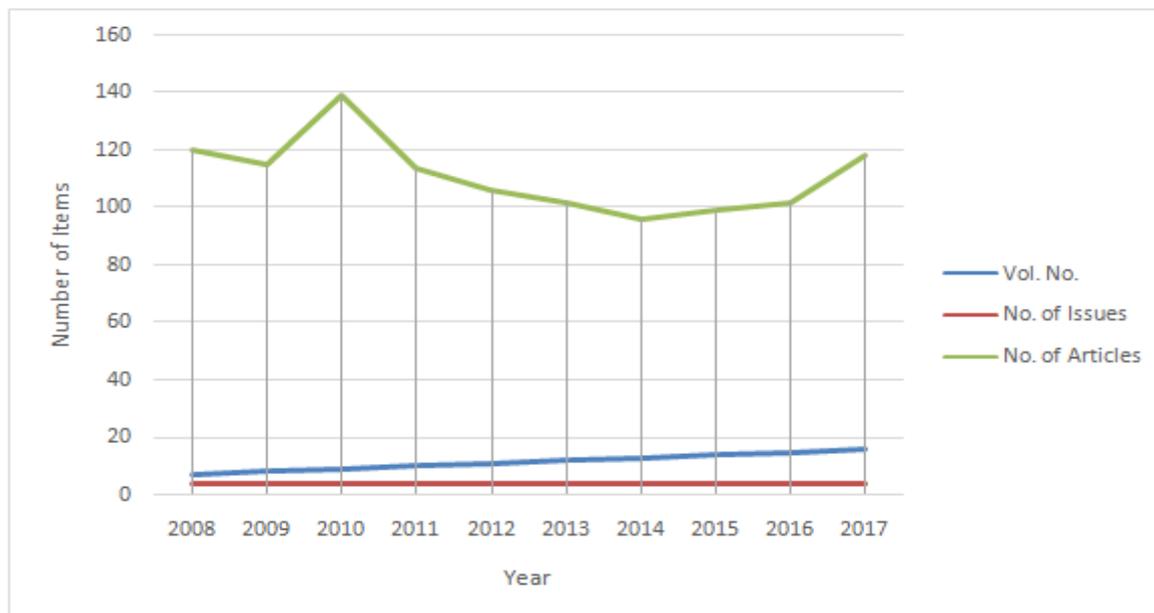


Fig 3 Volume –wise Distribution graph

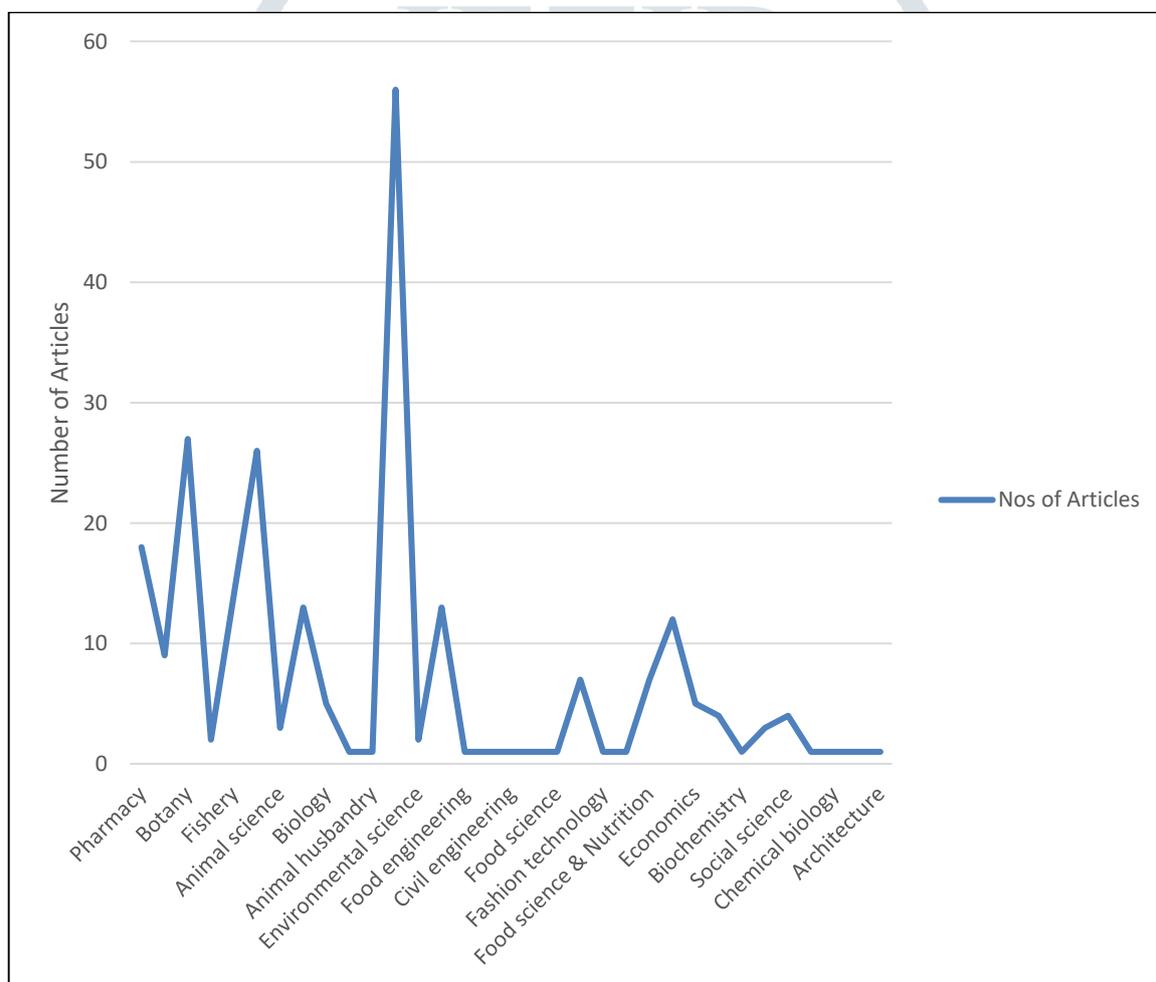


Fig 4 Subject-wise Distribution Graph

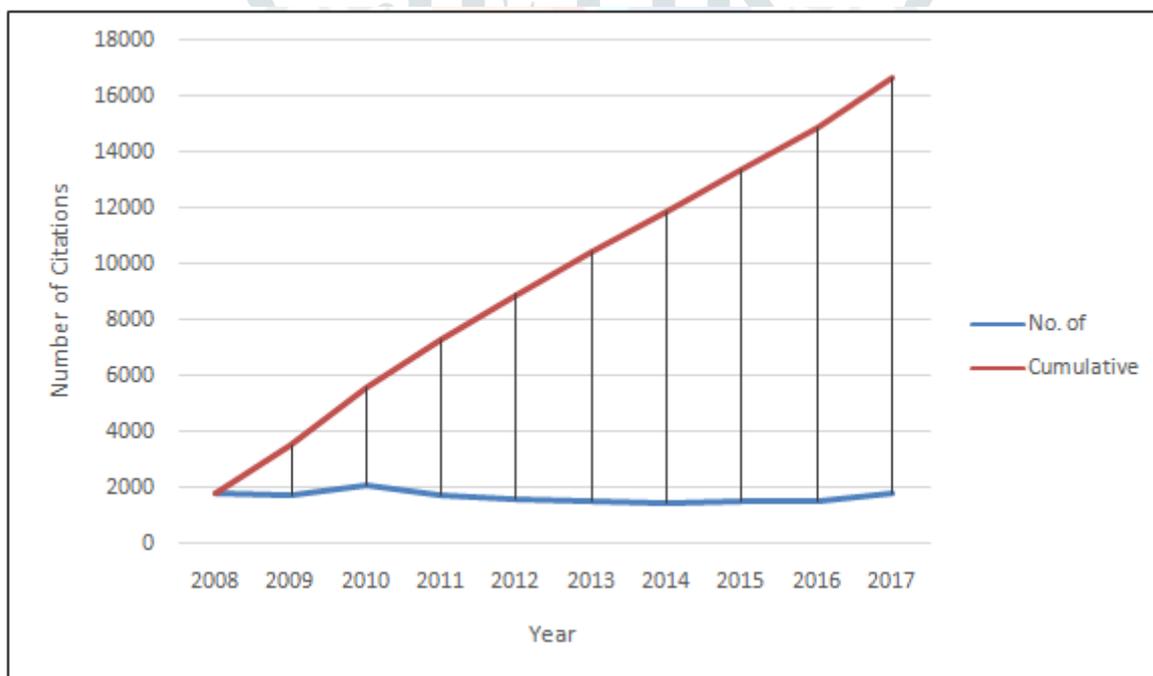


Fig 5 Year-wise Distribution of Journal Citations Graph
