

PEDAGOGICAL SKILLS DEVELOPMENT – TEACHER PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

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Abstract : Rapid growth of online education and the perceived difference between online and face-to-face teaching has require training and support for instructors transitioning to online delivery. It was found that Pedagogy Session should emphasize both technological and pedagogical skill development, evaluate participants' training needs prior to the training, and provide ongoing resources and support mechanisms after the training. The findings from the study inform administrators and professional development providers on how to plan and implement an instructor-training program to enhance online teaching skills. A review of publications in *Teaching and Teacher Education* on teacher professional development is the subject of the paper. The first part synthesises production referred to learning, facilitation and collaboration, factors influencing professional development, effectiveness of professional development and issues around the themes. - ▶ There are many responsibilities of being a teacher. Boundaries are about knowing where your role as a teacher stops. Try not to get personally involved with your learners. Always remain professional and act with integrity and impartiality. Always keep your conversations on a professional level. This means completely refraining from profanity, suggestive humour and overly personal discussions with students. - The study concludes that teachers have to encourage students to ask questions. Teachers must pay more emphasis on questions; not the answers. Be open to ideas. Mix up your learning techniques. Your teaching reaches beyond the classroom walls. Personalize your learning.
- Teachers should give lectures with the use of Audio, Video and Audio-visual aids. The students are very interested to learn lessons through Audio visual aids. Prior Knowledge is also required for a particular subject.
- Motivation. Of all of the factors that can affect how people learn, motivation might be the most important. Intellectual ability also affects learning. Attention spans vary among both children and adults. Prior knowledge is required while delivering the lecture.
- There are various types of training are Distance Learning/ Self study, A talk or Lecture, Peer Teaching, Read an Article, Show a Video, Discussion, Poster Presentation, Quizzes. The most effective types of Training in learning is Lecture with Audio –Visual Aids.
- Always Avoid Alliteration: Starting at the individual words in your writing, try to avoid putting words together that sound similar. Eliminate Repeating Words within Sentences. While there are some words you can safely repeat in a sentence, repeating a word with more than two syllables is risky.
