# Role of the Engineering Colleges Libraries in the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC):

In our country after independence there were huge and drastic changes in all the fields, including the field of education itself. In the beginning of the new developments in higher education there were only 30 colleges (1950-52) with 30 universities. Whereas if we compare the same with today's numbers we have more than 20,000 colleges and more than 500 universities which are having the authority to certify Bachelor's Degree as well as Master's Degree. In our country after independence.

This change has taken place only in the duration of 60 years. According to vast geographical expanse of our country and multiple language systems changing at every 100 to 200 km's distance, it was due and necessary for the Govt. to keep a clean watch on these colleges and respective universities to provide the

best and latest services to upcoming generations to come up with competition raising throughout the world in all the sectors of life. As very few students were capable of migrating outside the country for higher education it became mandatory for the Govt. to provide the same education in country itself with same standards and qualities.

UGC set up an inter university center i.e. NAAC in 1998 to evaluate and grade the universities and colleges in India. It is another initiative taken by the UGC to enhance and uplift the standard of higher education and academic libraries. According to NAAC's performance measuring scale the library is placed in the area of Infrastructural Facilities of a college. In the previous scale out of 100 only 40 marks were allotted for the Infrastructural Facilities of a college. Out of 40, 15 marks were allotted for the library (NAAC, 2006). This was the only means for evaluation of a college library system up to 2006. In 2007; NAAC reviewed their performance evaluation Method. In the new scale only 10 marks are allotted for the college library system (NAAC, 2007).

The libraries and information centers are as a hub of research oriented information. Its role can denied by education the masses. Libraries providing information on equality basis environment with all facilities. Libraries prepare individuals in an information based economy and productive employment.
