## **METHODOLOGY:**

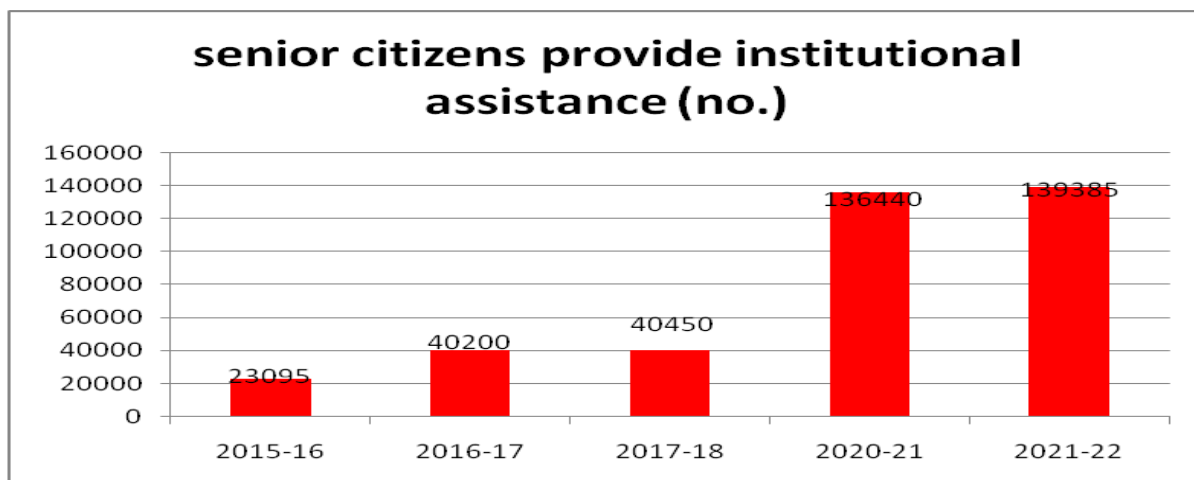
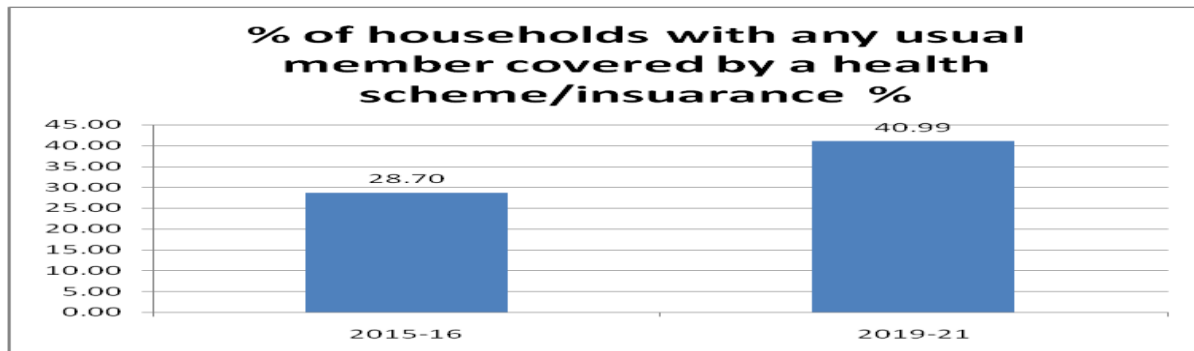
