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A study of Teachers' Awareness of News Education Policy (2020) relate to the Demographic factor

ABSTRACT

The New Education Policy (NEP) of 2020 has brought several significant changes to the Indian education system. This study aims to investigate the awareness of teachers about the NEP and how it relates to their demographic factors. A questionnaire was distributed among a sample of teachers, and their responses were analysed using descriptive statistics and inferential statistics. The study found that the awareness of the NEP among teachers was moderate, with a considerable proportion of teachers having limited knowledge about the policy. The analysis also revealed that factors such as age, gender, teaching experience, and educational qualifications were significant predictors of teachers' awareness of the NEP. This study suggests that efforts should be made to improve teachers' awareness of the NEP and its implications for the education system, particularly for those who are less informed. The findings of this study could be used by policymakers to develop strategies to effectively implement the NEP and enhance the quality of education in India.

HYPOTHESIS:

1. There is no significant difference in the level of awareness about NEP-2020 among male and female teachers.

2. There is no significant difference in the level of awareness about NEP-2020 among teachers with different types of schools.

METHODOLOGY :

The study used a survey method to collect data from teachers. The sample size of the study was 120 teachers from various schools of JODHPUR. The self-made questioner divided into three parts the first part was related to the demographic factor of teachers, the second part was related to the awareness of teachers about the new education policy and the third part was related to the perception of teachers about the implementation of NEP-2020.

DATA ANALYSIS :

The data collected from the survey questionnaire were analysed using descriptive statistics.

The demographic factors of the teachers were analysed using frequency distribution and percentage. The level of awareness of teachers regarding the NEP-2020 and its implementation was analysed using mean scores and standard deviation and percentile.


Analysis and interpretation of facts of research:-

There is no significant difference among secondary level teachers on awareness of New Education Policy (2020) based on gender.


GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF SECONDARY SCHOOLMALE AND FEMALE TEACHERS
