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The Role of Libraries in Shaping the College Students

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Abstract

Library is not only depository of knowledge but also information dissemination center, it collects variety of information sources in the form of print, non print and electronic sources and disseminates information in them by different library services. Academic library play a pivotal role in providing valuable services to its users viz. students, faculty etc. In academic libraries, librarians play a role of a teacher. The college librarian understands the information needs of students, helps them how to access the resources and motivates them towards their resources. This paper discusses the role of libraries in shaping the college students. The survey method was used to conduct the study and questionnaire was used as a data collection tool. The stratified random sampling technique was employed to choose the students. The study reveals that libraries plays and important role in shaping the students. Some students are facing problems to use the library efficiently and effectively and the study made some recommendations and suggestions to counter the problems.

Introduction

Libraries are synonymous with education, providing countless resources, namely books, internet access, printing facilities, and educational and professional training programs that can fuel economic, social, and cultural development. Library and Information Science helps to provide required input in all the fields in the form of knowledgeable manpower to utilize all other resources. An academic library is a specialized repository of knowledge and information within educational institutions, primarily universities, colleges, and research centers. Unlike public libraries, which cater to a broader audience, academic libraries are tailored to meet the specific needs of students, faculty, researchers, and other academic community members. These libraries play a crucial role in supporting the educational mission of their institutions by offering a wide range of resources that facilitate teaching, learning, and scholarly research. Books, journals, periodicals, and research papers covering various subjects and disciplines are

at the heart of an academic library's collection. These resources provide students and scholars with foundational academic study and research materials. User studies on usage of the library and information centers would help to find out drawbacks in libraries this in turn assist to overcome the problems in the library to provide effective and efficient services. User studies are more or less evaluative studies and gives proper direction to bring quality collection and services.

Literature Review

The Library as an institution exists for the benefits of a particular social group. It may be the citizens of a community member and students of an educational institutions or some larger or more specialized group. The library is a resource learning center and it is a service oriented Organization. User satisfaction is the important service of Library. Library is an essential prerequisite for successful implementation of higher educational programs. Library in colleges help the users in studies, research work, providing references, question bank, etc. Those who have a love for knowledge frequent to the Libraries and make use of materials available there. Many scholars have surveyed to get acquainted with role of library in shaping the students. Tadasad and Talikoto (2000) carried out a survey on awareness and utilization of resources and services of City Central Library, Gulbarga and found that majority users are satisfied with information services and visit library to borrow and return books. Mohindra and Kumar(2015) reported that majority 86.36 % of respondents visited the library for study purposes, followed by 129 (58.63 %) to borrow books, 51(23.2 %) respondents are using library web-pages daily, 71.49 % were of the view that library service attributes are helpful towards their academic success.

Methodology

The survey was conducted among the students of different colleges of Cooch Behar district. This study used random sampling technique to select 800 students of different colleges. A total of 500 questionnaires were distributed and got returned 451 filled in questionnaires. The response rate is 91%.

It consists of 2 sections where Section A about the general information such as name, gender, department, college name while Section B is specific close-ended questions relating to library services used by them, hour spend in library, improvements in library. In addition, the questionnaire was distributed to them online via email, whatsapp group, social media sites. To collect data of respondents for this study, students will take about 5-10 minutes to answer this survey. Data collected using Google form responses were calculated which the results below were showed using the pie chart. The detailed results are tabulated in the following section.

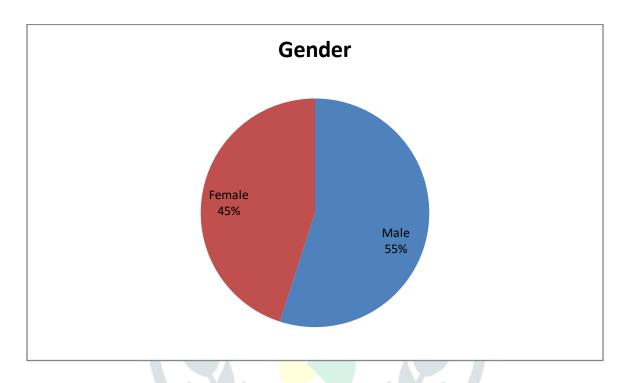


Figure 1: Gender of the respondents

Figure 2: Use of services among respondents

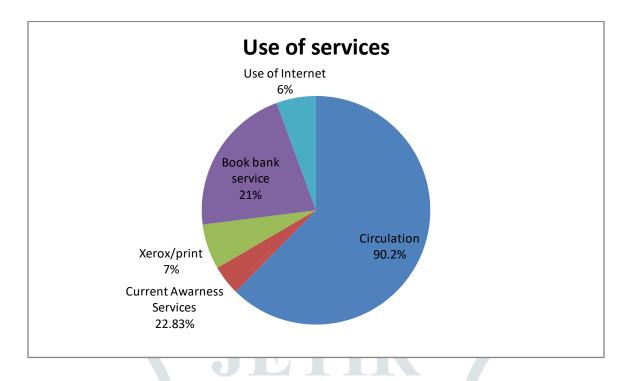

Figure 3: Frequency of use of Library

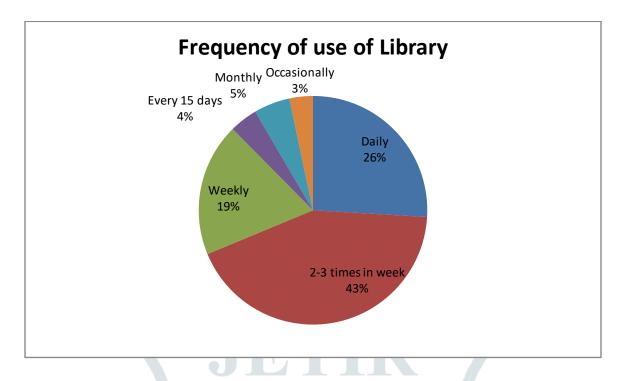

The response to the Frequency of using Library scattered from daily to occasionally. The above data in (Table 3) shows that 117 (26%) respondents visiting the library daily followed by 193 (43%) 2-3 times in a week. 85 (19%) visiting library weekly, 23(5%) visiting library once in a month. alternate day. While 18(4%) and 15 (3%) visiting library fortnightly and occasionally respectively. It is found that majority visiting 2-3 times in week.

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Figure 4: Time spend in library

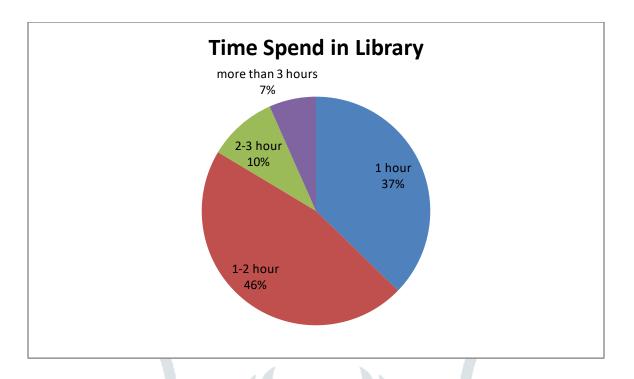

Figure 5: Does library helps in getting good academic score

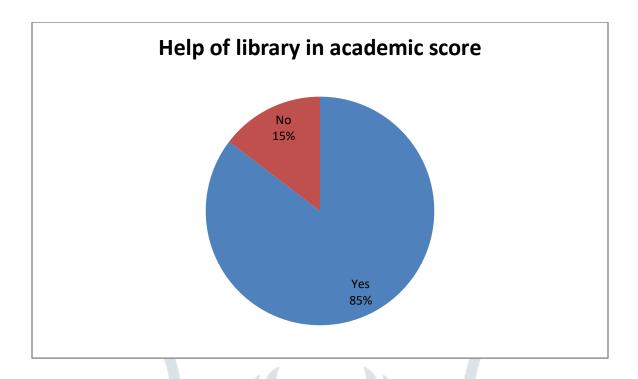

Suggestions received by the students
