Main features of Sustainable Development Goal-4-

In this study SDG-4 is highlighted because the aim of NEP 2020 align with the SDG-4. This goal specially highlight the inclusive & quality education. The main focus areas are discussed here

- a) Universal access to quality education – The SDG-4 aims to ensure quality education for all pupil at primary and secondary level and can access freely.
- b) Lifelong learning – SDG-4 also aims to promote lifelong learning for all from early childhood to adult education.
- c) Equity and Inclusion – SDG4 also committed to give equity and inclusion. It does not bother gender disparity. This goals aims to include all students regardless of their learning style, abilities and disabilities in same classroom.
- d) Literacy and Numeracy – One of the target of SDG4 is to make capable all the learners, achieving literacy and elementary numeracy skills.
- e) Vocational training and technical education – Beside the theoretical part, SDG-4 also give emphasis on vocational training course and technical education for the future of the learners.

- f) ESD and global citizenship – By 2030, every learners must have received an education that aim of obtaining the understanding and skills necessary to promote sustainable development. Role of NEP 2020 in sustainable development :-

It is “an education system rooted in Indian, ethos that contributes directly to transforming India, that is Bharat, sustainably into an equitable and vibrant knowledge society by providing high quality education to all, thereby making India a global knowledge superpower.” The five guiding pillars of this policy are Accessibility, Equity, Quality, Affordability and Accountability.

The main features of NEP-2020 -

- a) Holistic and Multidisciplinary Education – NEP 2020 emphasizes a shift towards holistic and multidisciplinary education which includes fostering intellectual, aesthetic, social, physical, emotional and moral development in an integrated manner.
- b) Flexible Curriculum – NEP 2020 promotes a flexible curriculum that allows students to choose subjects based on their interests rather than being restricted. to traditional disciplinary boundaries.
- c) Practical skills- NEP 2020 emphasizes the integration of practical skills and hands-on experience in the curriculum. It focuses on developing critical thinking, problem-solving, creativity among students.

- d) Integration of vocational courses – This policy aims to integrate vocational streams within the general stream. In higher education beside the core courses, there are summer internship course for the students to choose different career option.
- e) Integration of Value Added Course – This policy also integrated compulsory Value Added Course with the general core courses. Environmental Education Is one of the compulsory VAC in higher education. Which make the students aware about climate change, natural hazards, resource depletion etc.
- f) Including Indian Knowledge System – NEP 2020 give emphasis the integration of Indian Knowledge System (IKS) into the curriculum across various disciplines including science, technology, engineering, mathematics, humanities and social sciences. This integration recognizes the rich intellectual heritage of India and seeks to foster a deeper understanding of its diverse knowledge traditions, including philosophy, science, mathematics and arts.
- g) Integration of technology – The NEP 2020 give more emphasis on use of technology in classrooms to enhance the learning outcomes. Digital literacy and online learning of education can increase more accessibility of education.
- h) Teacher training- NEP 2020 focuses on teacher training as for their professional development and to make eligible to as a good teacher who can serve the pupil according to new policy. Teacher will be eligible to spread Indian Knowledge System and aware the people about different global issues.
- i) Research and Innovation – This policy focuses on the research and innovation beside different job opportunities to make the earth peaceful. The NEP 2020 encourage to continue research on sustainable development.

From the above discussion it is clean that NEP 2020 is align with the principles of Education for Sustainable Development (ESD).
