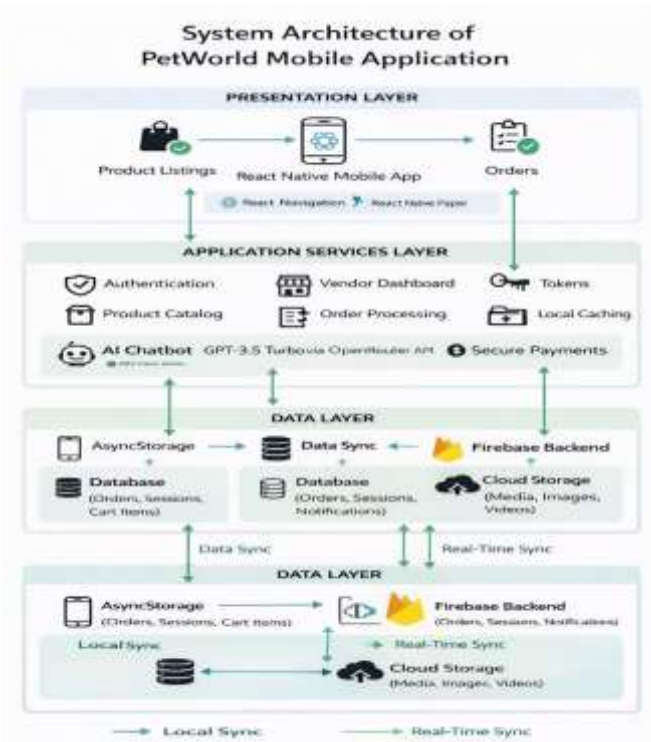
### III. PROPOSED METHODOLOGY

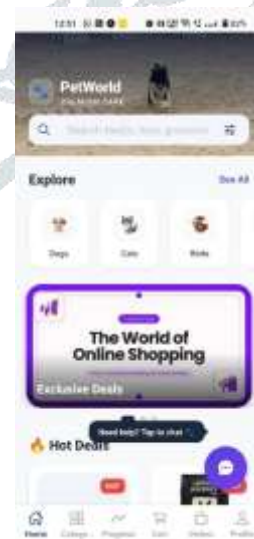


Fig. Main Screen

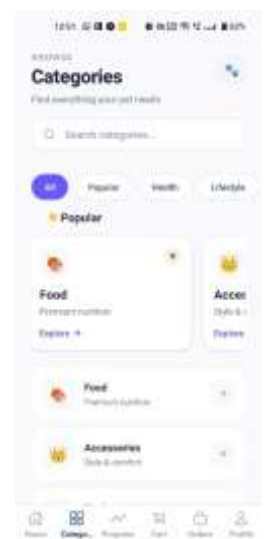


Fig. Categories Screen

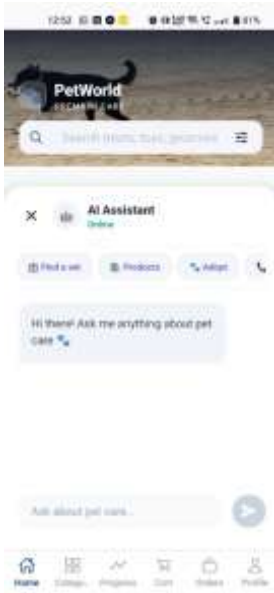


Fig. Chatbot Screen

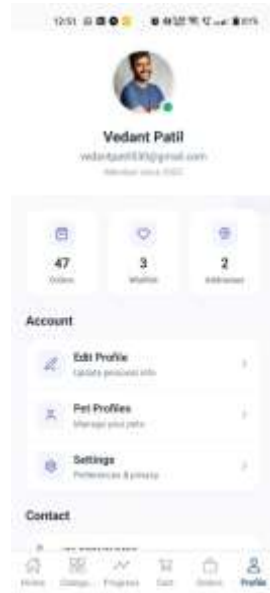


Fig. Profile Screen
